NSFA Accident Support Scheme

The NSFA has a Player Accident Support Policy via FNSW with JLT Sport being the appointed Broker. SLE Insurance is the insurance company. This policy is **NOT** to be viewed as a “private” health insurance, but does offer some limited assistance in many costs.

When a player has to be transported from the field of play by ambulance, the cost is borne by the player or the parent/guardian. Neither the NSFA, nor its affiliates bear any responsibility for the payment of ambulance bills. SLE may pay up to 75% of an ambulance bill providing the correct procedures have been followed.

If making an insurance claim the following must be adhered to:-

- Once completed the claim must be signed by your Club.
- The next step is to have the NSFA (the Association) sign off on the claim.
- Claims can be submitted to [SLE](#) by the Association or the person making the claim.
- Claim should be completed and lodged within 90 days of the incident.
- All further contact must be with SLE following their provision of Case number to the player.
