



Miniroos Gala Day

Mixed Miniroos – Saturday, 26th August

Girls Miniroos – Sunday, 27th August

Mixed Miniroos U6 & U7

- Each squad divides into 2 teams as per usual. Players must stay in the same team for the duration of a match and cannot move between the two squads until after a match has ended.
- All teams are entered into 3-team pools or 4-team pools.
- In 3-team pools, games consist of two (2) 10-minute halves. Each squad will play 2 games. There will be a 10-minute gap between games.
- In 4 team pools, games consist of two (2) 7.5-minute halves, no half time break. Each squad will play 3 games.
- No points will be awarded for wins, draws, losses or corners.
- Normal Miniroos rules will apply to all games.

Girls Miniroos G6 & G7

- All Teams would require a minimum of 4 players to participate in the Gala Day. Teams will be placed in pools of either 3 or 4 teams.
- In 4-team pools, each team will play 3 games. Games will consist of two (2) 7.5-minute halves, no half time break.
- In 3-team pools, each team will play 2 games. Games will consist of two (2) 10-minute halves. There will be a 10-minute gap between games.
- Gala Day is non-competitive, meaning no points or scores will officially be recorded.

Mixed and Girls Miniroos U8 - U11 & G8 - G11

- Gala Day for Under 8's to Under 11's is non-competitive, meaning no points or scores will officially be recorded.
- Teams will be placed in pools of either 3 or 4 teams. In 4-team pools, each team will have three games. Games will consist of two (2) 10-minute halves, no half time break.
- In 3-team pools, games consist of two (2) 15-minute halves. Each team will play two games. There will be a 15-minute gap between games.

NOTE - SAP Gala Day will be separate from the Miniroos Gala Day. SAP Gala Day will be scheduled on Saturday, 9th September at NTRA Field 1 (Synthetic).
