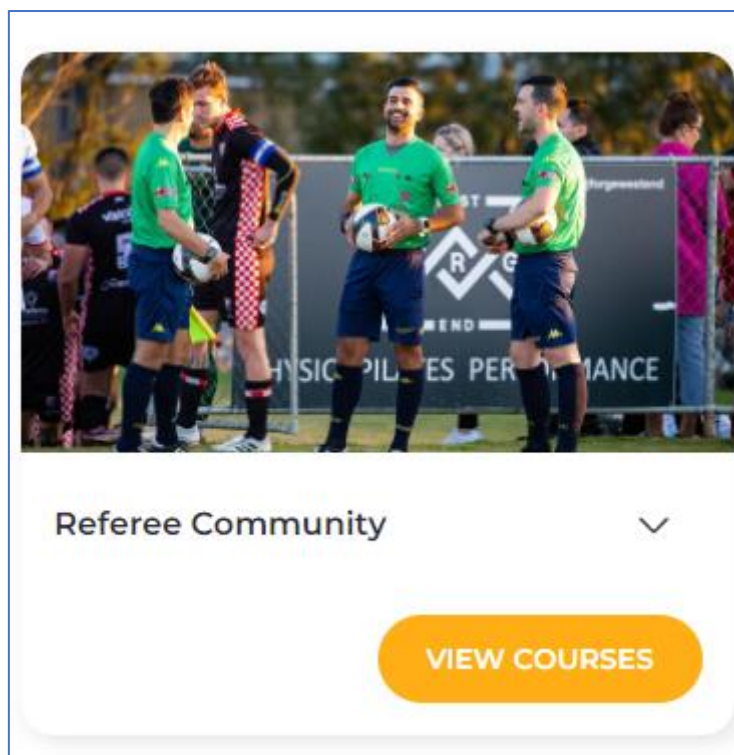


Step 2: Once you have completed your NSW Learner registration, you will be sent an email to say your registration has been approved.

Step 3: Within one business day, you will then be able to head to eTrainU to sign in with your new log in details [\[click here to register\]](#).

Step 4: Click on Learner option in the bottom right-hand corner. If you have any log-in issues, please contact etrainu@playfootball.com.au.

Step 5: On the left-hand side, click on training library, then click on Referee Community courses



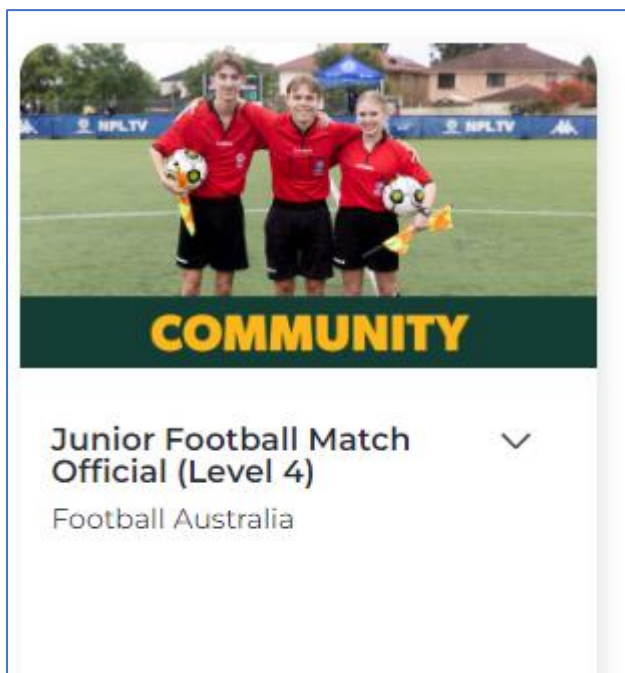
Step 6: Please go through to "Laws of the Game" and complete the modules. This part will take roughly 5 hours and can be done at your own time. This can be done in stages or one continuous period.

You must complete all modules before you can register and pay for a practical course. Practical course registrations and payments are completed in the next step.



Step 7: After completion of the Laws of the Game modules, you will be required to complete the Junior Football Match Official (Level 4) module followed by our NSFRA practical course.

Step 8: You will need to locate a course with NSFRA. Firstly, click on the Junior Football Match Official (Level 4) module.



Please search **FNSW - Northern Suburbs Football Association** in the Member Associations option (top left search bar). It will provide you with the calendar of options available. Please select on the date most suitable for your practical day attendance.

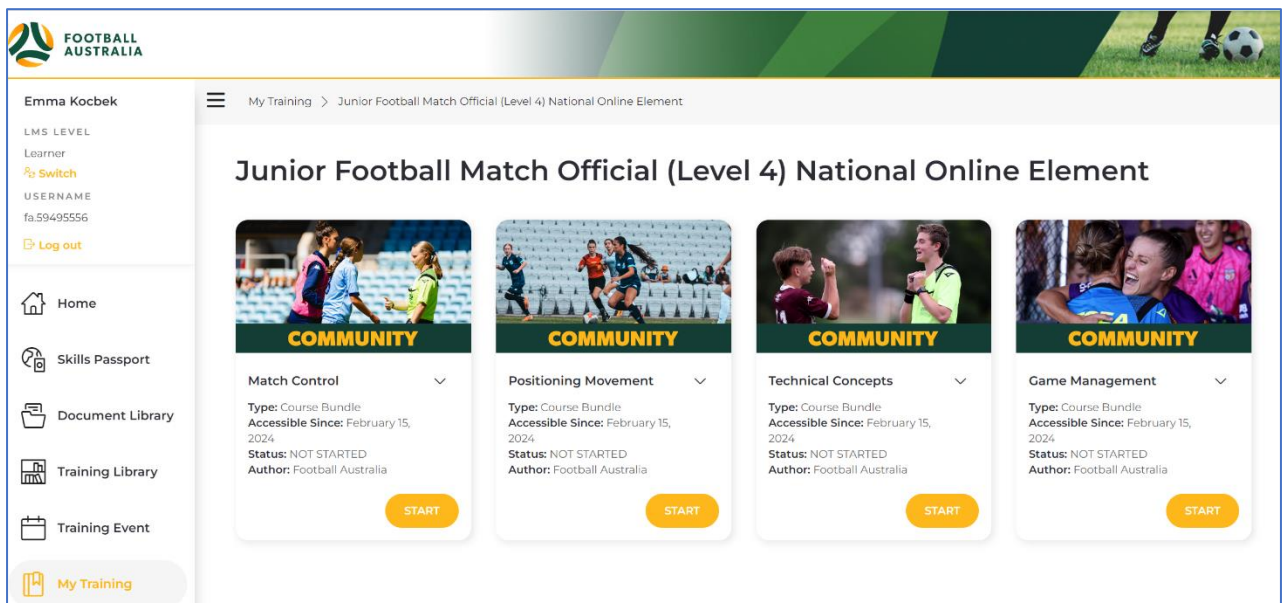
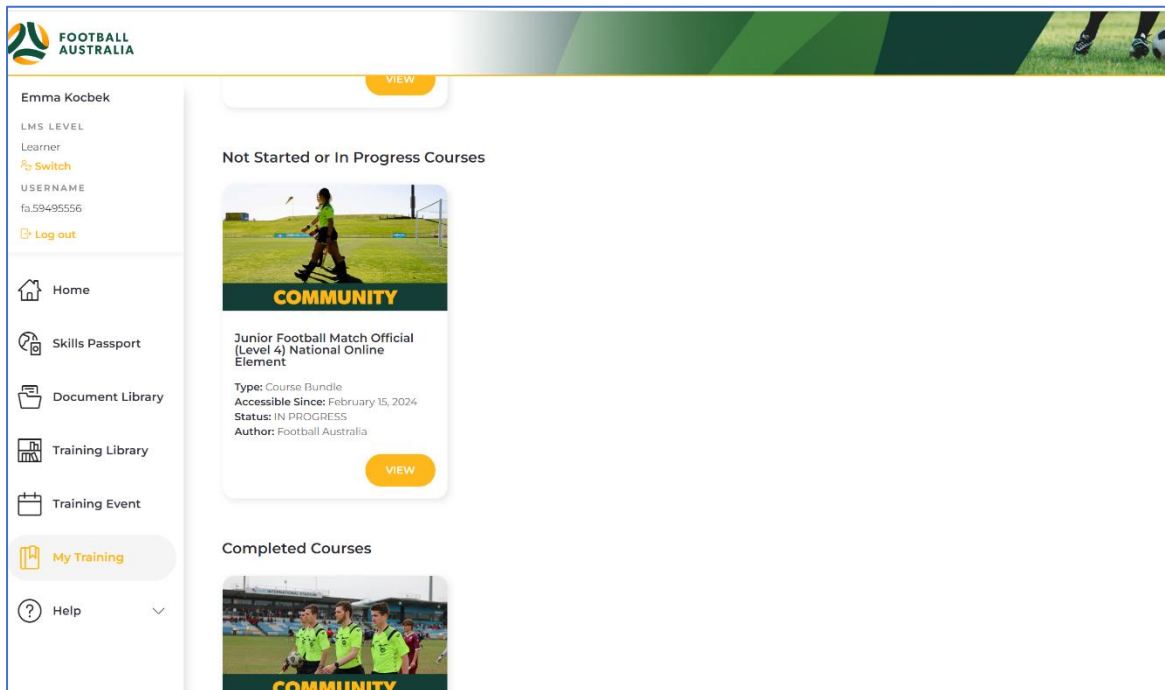

Step 3: Input your Working with Children's Check (WWC) number.

Warning: If you are under 18 during the season, you are not required to have a WWC number. Please choose the "No" option for this question, then "YES" to having an exception. The reason is because you are under 18.

If you are over 18, you must have a **PAID** WWC number. Please complete the relevant steps with Service NSW to ensure this is done correctly.
