


Step 2: Once you have completed your NSW Learner registration, you will be sent an email to say your registration has been approved.

You must complete all modules before you can register and pay for a practical course. Practical course registrations and payments are completed in the next step.




Step 7: After completion of the Laws of the Game modules, you will be required to complete the Junior Football Match Official (Level 4) module followed by our NSFRA practical course.

Step 8: You will need to locate a course with NSFRA. Firstly, click on the Junior Football Match Official (Level 4) module.






