Hosted at the Northern Suburbs Football Association (NSFA) home of football, the NSFA is proud to announce a new competition for primary school boys, The Sutton Cup. Bringing together primary school teams from across the Northern Suburbs of Sydney, the tournament intends to provide a fun and enjoyable playing experience for boys to showcase their skill and teamwork whilst representing their school.

The NSFA Sutton Cup is named after Ben Sutton, who is a Pararoo with 12 international caps and 3 goals for the national side. Ben is also heavily involved in the NSFA community as a player, coach and an educator. He has been a huge presence in the International Day of People w/ Disability Gala Day that NSFA has been involved with for 3 years and hosted in December 2023. Ben's biggest success story is probably the creation of the Pararoos Development Centre (PDC), that he continues to manage and run today. The PDC was started in 2020 and aims to provide footballing development training to children and adults with Cerebral Palsy and Acquired Brain Injury.

The NSFA Sutton Cup is inspired after the success of the NSFA Skellern and Thea Slatyer Cup's. These tournaments are for Primary School and High School Girl's and have been a massive success in previous years.

The Skellern Cup, named after Amanda and Kimberly Skellern, has been running since 2017 and has engaged over 3,000 girls in this time.

The Slatyer Cup, named after ex-Tigers and Matilda's footballer Thea Slatyer, had it's inaugural event last year in November 2023 with over 650 players attending across the 2-days.

NSFA Sutton Cup Important Information

The NSFA Sutton Cup will take place across two days of Term 1, providing all primary school aged boys in Year 3 – 6 the chance to take part in our association wide football gala day.

Each day will bring together schools and boys from throughout the Northern Suburbs of Sydney, inviting over 40 schools, stretching from Neutral Bay to Brooklyn. Each school can nominate up to 4 teams, with a recommended squad size of 11-13 players plus a coach/teacher. Games will be played on small-sided fields of 7v7 for Junior and 9v9 for senior, with a competition winner awarded following our unique points system.

The day intends to celebrate boys playing football, bringing together regular players and non-players to showcase the inclusiveness, enjoyment and camaraderie football as a sport provides.

Juniors will play 7v7 on Tuesday 27th February - Year 3 & 4

Seniors will play 9v9 on Wednesday 28th February - Year 5 & 6

LOCATION:

All games will be played at the NSFA Home of football, North Turramurra Recreational Area (NTRA), North Turramurra. The newly built facility boasts three full size football fields, amenities, and parking to accommodate hundreds of players and spectators. Map below.

PARKING:

NTRA has over 250 parking spots, including bus bays.

FACILITIES:

North Turramurra Recreational Area (NTRA) has amenities facilities, with two change rooms and public toilets.

FIRST AID & RISK ASSESSMENT:

On both days of the tournament a first aid tent will be set up next to the competition coordinators table. A first aid officer will be on hand to assist, along with ice and medical supplies. A risk assessment will be completed and sent to all schools on request and prior to the tournament.

FOOD AND DRINK:

A canteen will be in operation on both days to provide much needed sustenance to the players, spectators, and teachers during the football-centric day.

FOOTBALL GUIDELINES

Playing formats:

Juniors – Year 3 & 4 boys will play a 7 vs 7 format on fields 40m in length, 30m wide. 25 min games. All teams will play with goals of 3m x 2m, with a maximum of three substitutes per team.

Seniors – Year 5 & 6 boys will play 9 vs 9 format on fields 65m in length, 45m wide. 25 min games. All teams will play with goals of 5m x 2m, with a maximum of four substitutes per team.



Playing rules:

The NSFA Sutton Cup will follow NSFA MiniRoos competition regulations.

The NSFA Sutton Cup will implement a unique set of criteria each school must work towards in order to be awarded NSFA Sutton Cup winners.

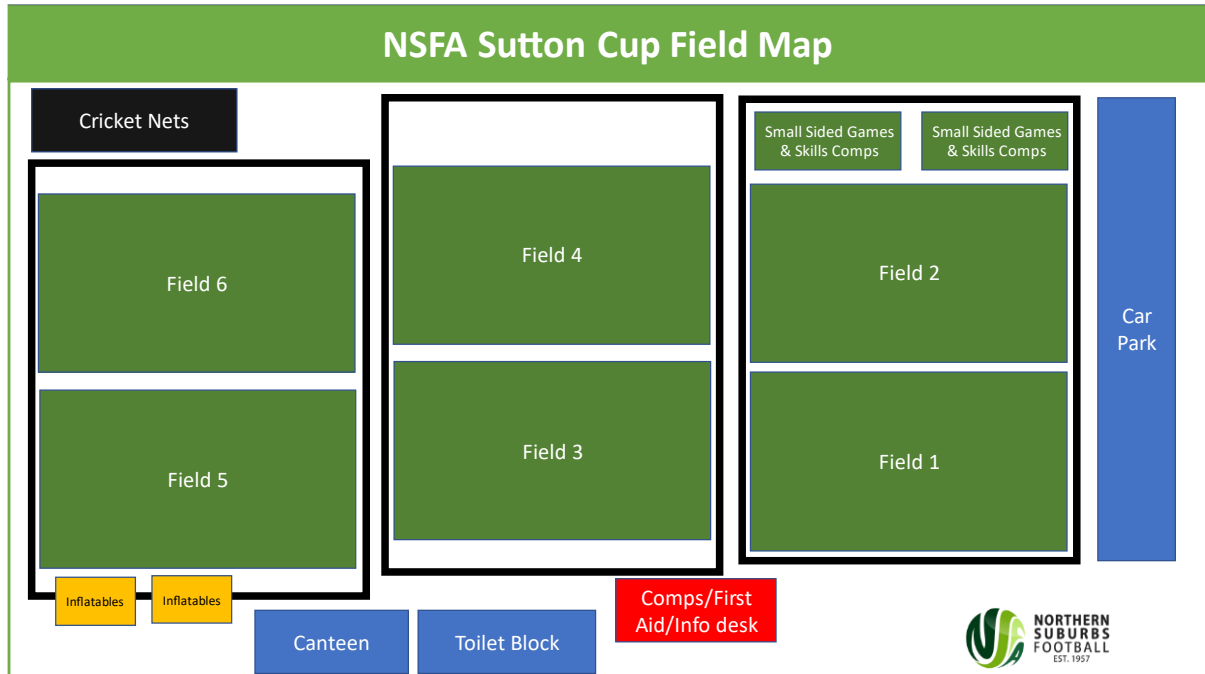
The following points will be **awarded only ONCE** during the day by Ben Sutton!
